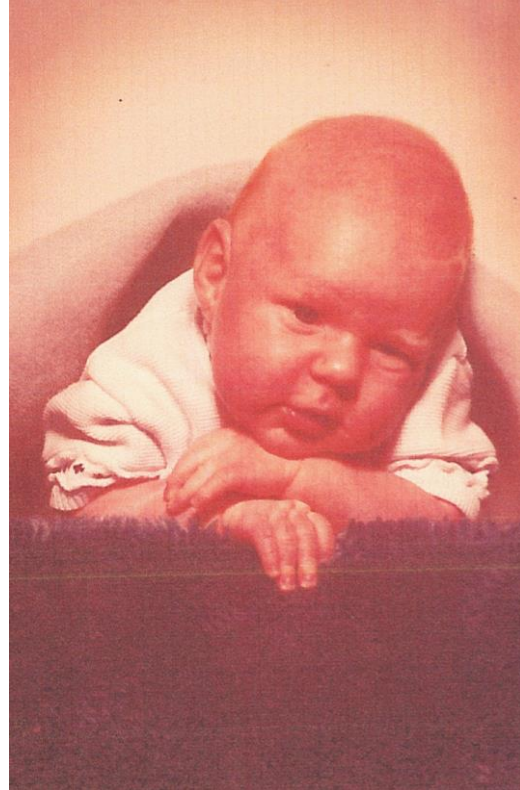

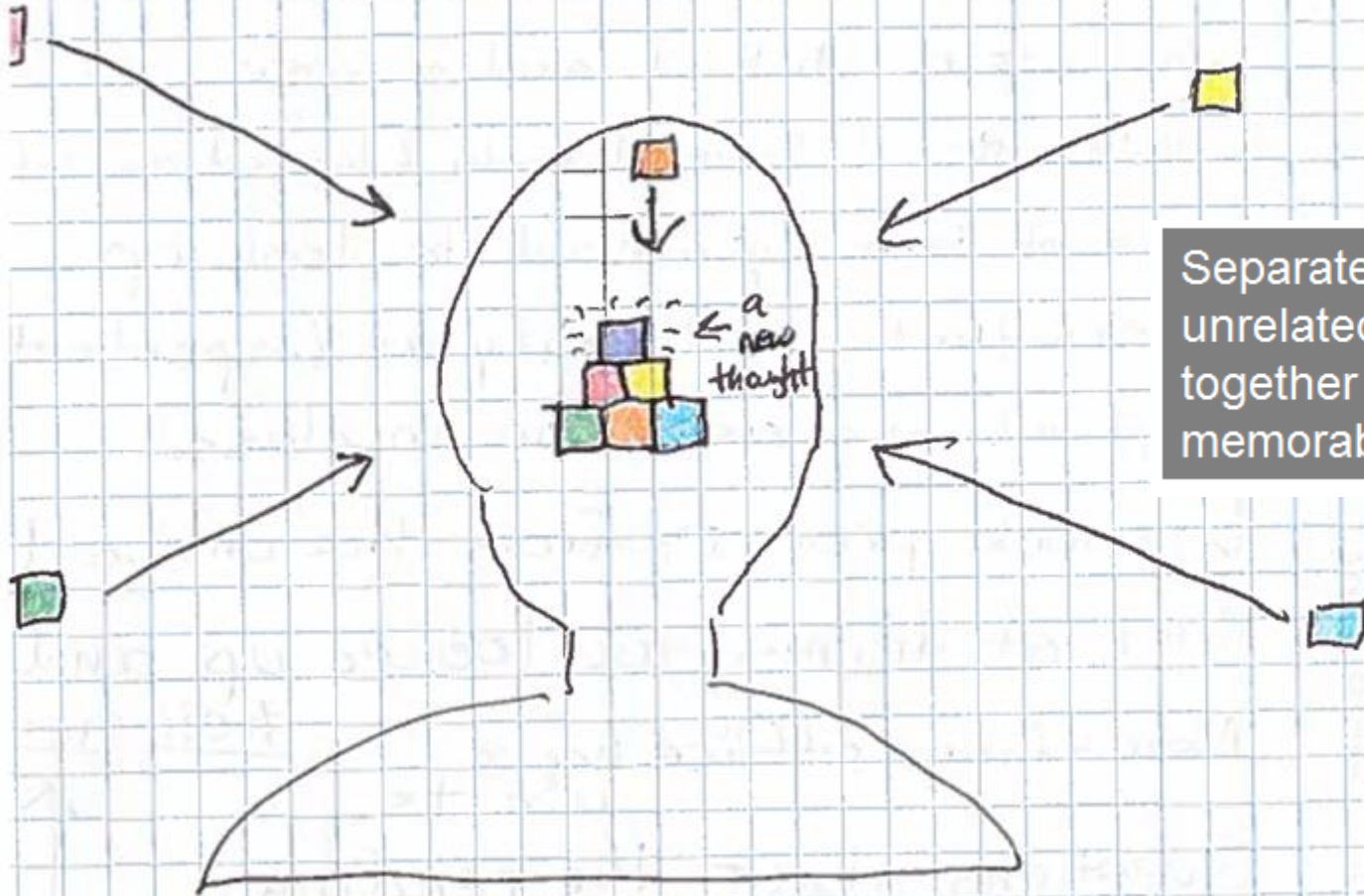

Why is it called a daybook?

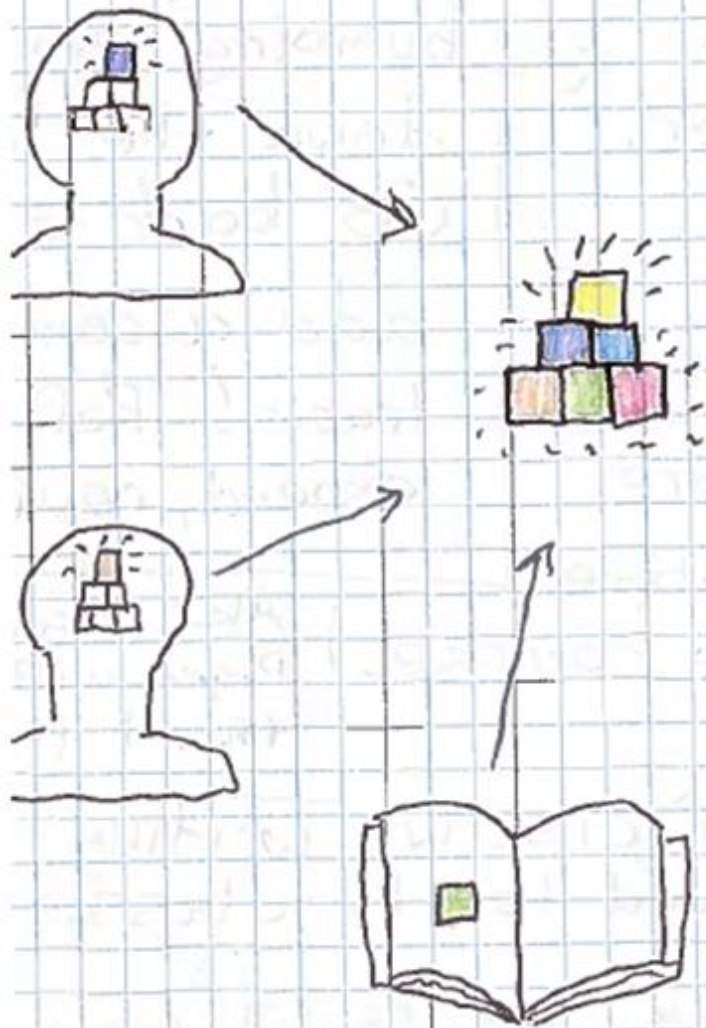
Because you write

What is the shape of learning?



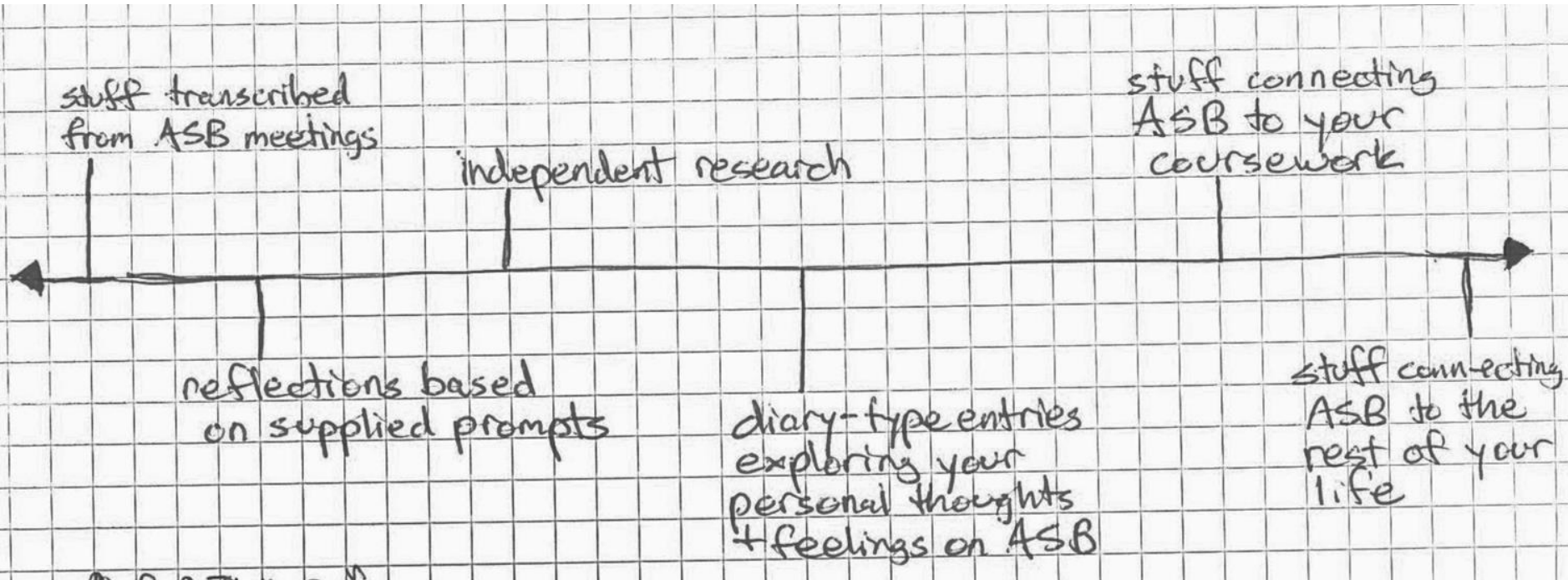
Separate or seemingly unrelated ideas come together to build a memorable connection.

LEADERSHIP DEVELOPMENT

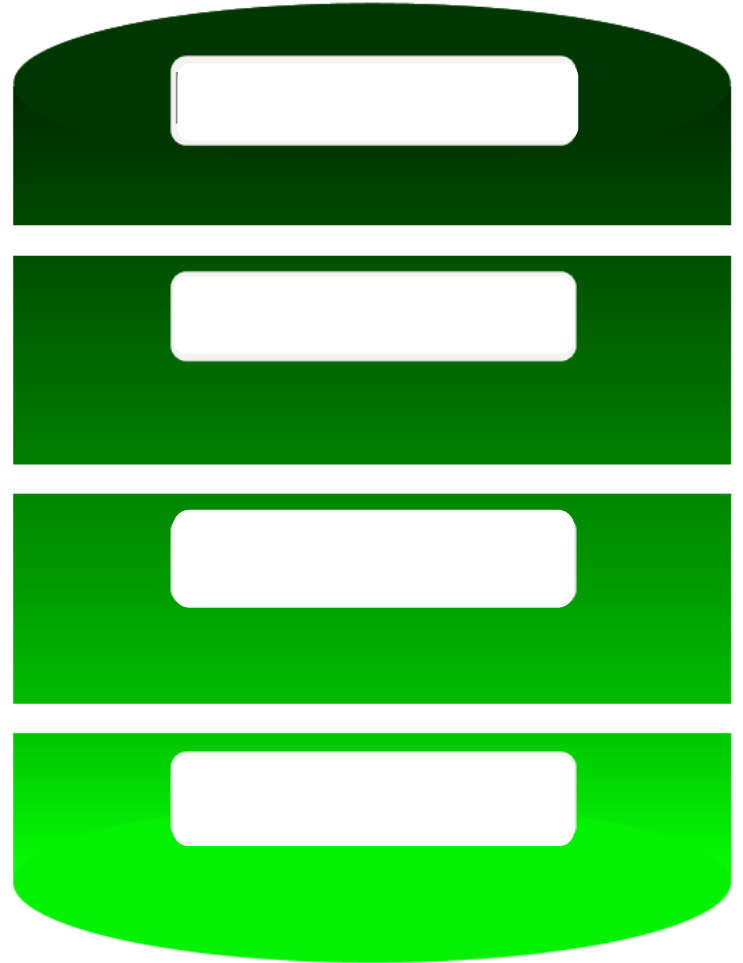
Learn how to lead and identify your leadership skills by collaborating with others to make a difference.
