

## "Snowball" Questions



- Question: How long is the bus ride?  
Answer: 10 hours; with stops about 12
- Question: What was your favorite part about bus ride?  
Answer: Movies, music, Waffle House
- Question: Can you choose where to sit?  
Answer: We will sit with reflection groups
- Question: Anything else we should know about the bus?  
Answer: It can get a little chilly.
- Question: What clothes should we pack?  
Answer: Work boots or sneakers; clothes that can get dirty!
- Question: Do we have to buy work gloves?  
Answer: They are recommended
- Question: What is our housing like?  
Answer: Bunk beds (bring sleeping bag to put on mattress); men and women separated; about 10 in a cabin; 3 showers per cabin
- Question: Do we have to buy the listed t-shirts or are they provided?  
Answer: You will be provided the AB shirt; bring a green/lime shirt (there is a possibility we will provide it); bring a Redbird shirt; bring an Honors shirt
- Question: Is there anything not on the packing list?  
Answer: Bring more than one sweatshirt
- Question: How early are we leaving?  
Answer: 8 am on Sunday; we will congregate at 7:30 at the Bone information desk
- Question: How long are we working on the site each day?  
Answer: Working at both CTL and Habitat house; approximately 10am-3pm with lunch break
- Question: Should we be writing in our daybook now or when the trip starts?  
Answer: Start now! It can only help you. It's also good practice for the trip; at minimum, please respond to "Fruit for Thought" prompts
- Question: Will we be decorating daybooks on trip?  
Answer: Decorate now; we won't bring those supplies on the trip

Question: What is a typical day like during the trip?  
Answer: Wake up around 7:45 to eat breakfast and get ready. Pack a lunch and water bottle; head to site until about 3; free time and shower. Dinner. Reflection

Question: How am I supposed to fit a sleeping bag and pillow in my one suitcase?  
Answer: You can bring one bag and a separate sleeping bag to store under the bus! You will probably want your pillow on the bus.

Question: Can we use CTL amenities during week?  
Answer: Most will be for free day only, but some will be available

Question: How often will the bus make pit stops?  
Answer: About every 2 hours

Question: When do we go to bed?  
Answer: "Lights out" at 10pm, but you could stay outside (for example at the bonfire) later than 10

Question: Is there electricity in the cabins?  
Answer: Yes ☺

Question: What can we do when we are not at the work site?  
Answer: You won't feel bored. It will be busy!

Question: How often can we shower?  
Answer: Daily! 3 per cabin

Question: Zip line?  
Answer: Yes!

Question: Food good?  
Answer: Well, we hope.

Question: Do we have to wear the recommended t-shirts?
