

Gather the following pieces of information:





- ☐ A list of the Advanced Placement and/or IB tests you have taken or plan to take and the scores (if known)
- ☐ A recommendation from the Illinois State University language placement exam/readiness test, if you completed it (information about this is in the next section)
- ☐ A list of your grades from Math and World Language classes taken in high school

Are you interested in taking a French, German, Italian, or Spanish course?



French, German, Italian, and Spanish offer online placement exams/readiness tests. If you are interested in taking one of these languages in the fall, complete the placement exam from the Languages, Literatures, and Cultures website **BEFORE** you start the form.

Frequently Asked Questions

Can I make changes to my schedule?

Yes, you will be able to make changes based on course availability.

If I already have a tentative fall class schedule, do I still need to participate in Preview?

Yes, you still need to participate in Preview, during which time you will meet individually with an Honors advisor.

How many classes will I take?

Your schedule will include 4 or 5 classes, which is typically 13 – 16 credit hours.

ALEKS Math Placement

- The ALEKS Math Placement Assessment is used to determine placement in the appropriate math course.
- With your benefit of early registration, you should complete ALEKS as soon as possible.
- If you completed dual credit courses or Advanced Placement exams, you may be exempt from completing ALEKS. To confirm if your credit fulfills the requirement for your major, please contact honors@ilstu.edu.
- The placement is up to 25 questions and generally takes 60 90 minutes. Plan to take ALEKS when you can devote your full attention without any distractions.
- Many students take ALEKS more than once in order to improve their score. You might find that your skills are a little rusty, so there are individualized prep and learning modules to help you practice after your first attempt.
