


Supporting YOUR STUDENT

Many incoming freshmen might not realize packing for college also involves the process of tracking down **valuable paperwork** and **documentation of accomplishments**. Honors students are encouraged to **store copies** of AP scores and transcripts in their **expandable folders**. You can support your student's transition to campus by reviewing the following checklist:

- Send final high school transcript to Illinois State University.
- Send records of dual-credit coursework from the corresponding community college to Illinois State University.
- Send community college transcripts to Illinois State University—especially if coursework was completed this summer—to avoid registration delays.
- After receiving AP scores (from senior year and/or previous high school semesters):
 - Make a copy of the letter(s).
 - Email your Honors Advisor (or honors@ilstu.edu) with your name, UID, and AP score(s).

Your student should:

- Frequently check ISU Office 365 email.
- Save his/her "STATE YOUR HONORS" **expandable folder, flash drive, and all Preview documentation**.
- Review the sample Plan of Study and/or any information provided by his/her department/school.
- Plan to attend the Welcome Week Honors EXPO on **Friday, August 19** from **9:30 – 10:30 am**.



The red "STATE YOUR HONORS" folder, handouts, and flash drive are required materials for Honors Mindset Seminar.
