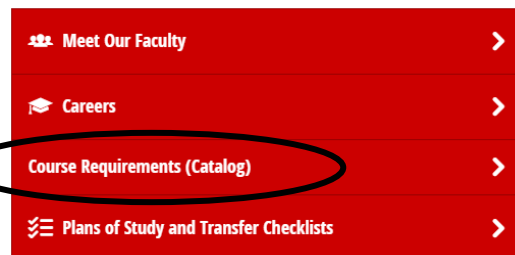
# Tips to Complete the Honors Advising Appointment Preparation Worksheet

Review the courses required for your major, specific graduation requirements, as well as how General Education fits with your major. You can also view a Sample Plan of Study.

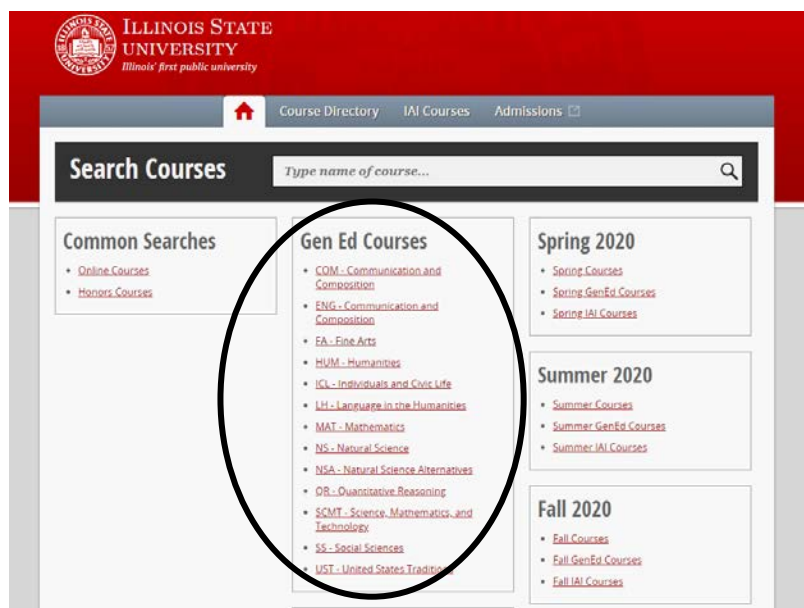
