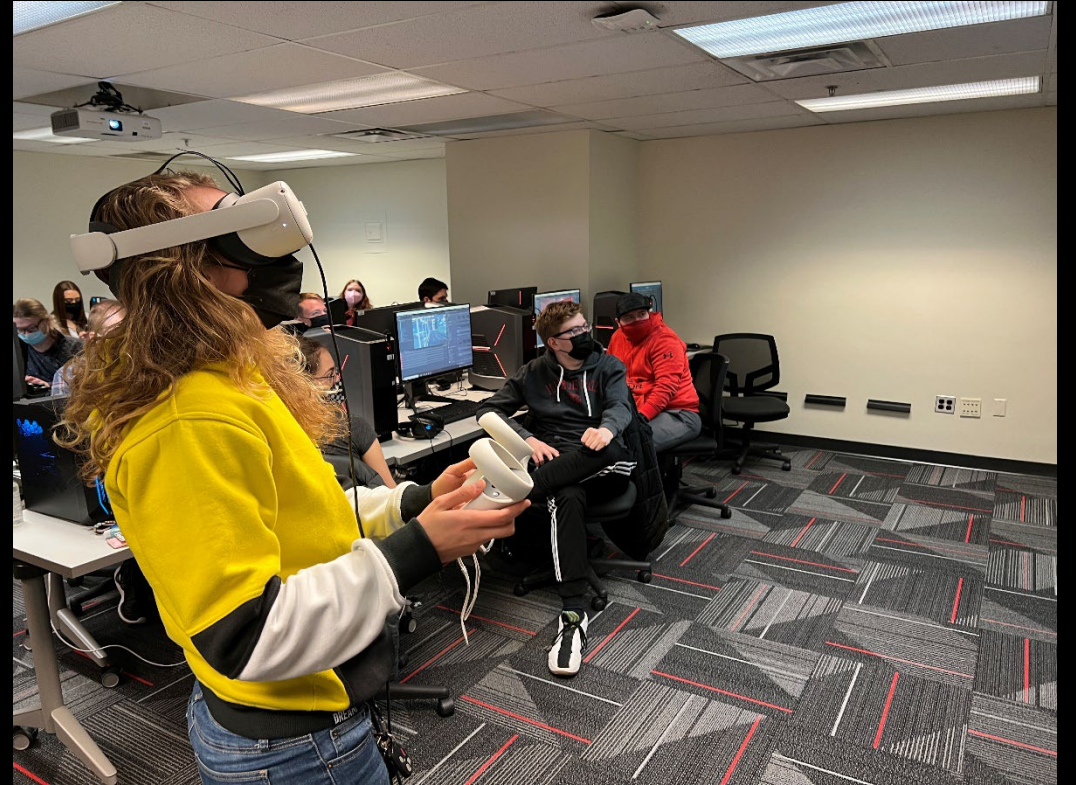

Virtual Reality



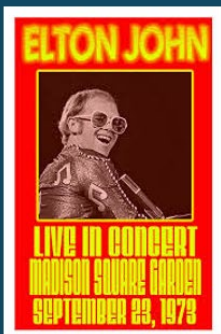
# Honors Explorations

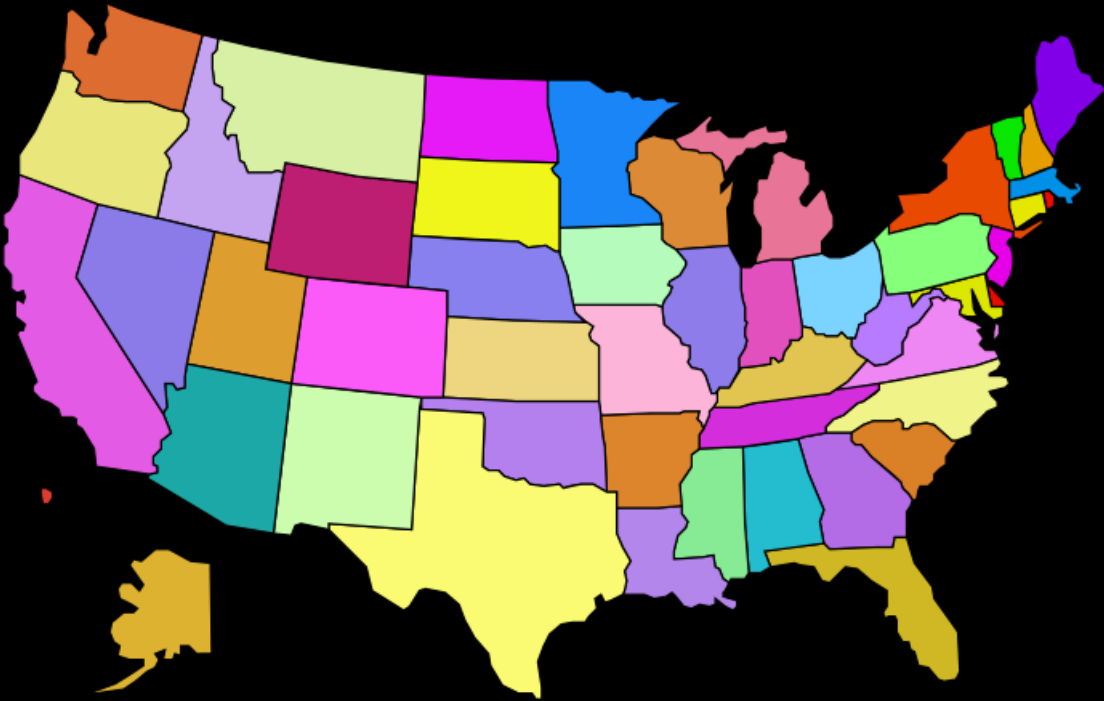
