<p>Role</p>	<p>Honors Equity, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI) Mentors are part of the Honors student leadership team. This position will serve as a mentor to students who identify as coming from underrepresented backgrounds and identities and help build a sense of community within the Honors Program.</p>
<p>Description</p>	<p>Honors EDI Mentors will:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Create community among Honors students of various background and identities. • Serve as a guide/support for mentee Honors students. • Communicate at least one time per week with their mentees in a face-to-face format; additional optional touch points can be by phone, e-mail, social media, etc. • Complete documentation after checking in with mentees. • Monitor the progress of assigned students and be knowledgeable of appropriate support services to offer mentees. • Attend mentor program meetings, training sessions, orientation and programs. • Notify the Mentor supervisor of any concerns regarding the academic, financial, and personal welfare of the students. • ABIDE BY ALL CONFIDENTIALITY (FERPA) LAWS. • Be in good standing in the Honors Program. <p>Honors EDI Mentors must be available on Friday mornings from 11:00am - 12:00pm to attend weekly team meetings throughout the fall semester. There are no exceptions to this expectation.</p> <p>Fall 2024 EDI Mentors must also be available for training on Wednesday, August 14 and the morning of Thursday, August 15. Some meals will be provided throughout the training experience.</p>
